It has been a challenging year, and I am very grateful to be working with the committed volunteer Board of Directors who have never failed to step up when called upon to do so.

While we work towards ensuring the Museum has a sustainable future, we must remember that we stand on a strong foundation, one that has been built not only by the women who had the foresight to start the Museum, but by all those who have so selflessly given of themselves as volunteers, donors, and participants.

I thank you for your support in the past, and humbly request even more of you in the future. As always, we are only as strong as our members. The Museum is our dream and together there is no telling what we may do.

Thank you to the Board of Directors, Jen and the Museum staff, the volunteers, and all of you. I appreciate being a part of this incredible organization as we move forward.

Executive Director & CEO's Message



It goes without saying that the 2021-22 fiscal year was an exceptionally challenging period for the Ukrainian Museum of Canada. I arrived at the Museum as Executive Director and CEO on May 9, 2022, just over a month following the fiscal year's conclusion. At that time, the Museum had only recently been reopened to the public, following its prologued COVID closure, and opening hours were very limited. The Museum had also lost staff members and had been operating, since Fall 2021, under the direction of former and current Board members who stepped in to fill key leadership functions and ensure we continued to fulfil our mission and service to members and the public.

Being new to the UMC and coming in to take on the vital work of capacity-building and regrowth, I have been consistently impressed by the dedication, hard work, and thoughtfulness of the Museum's Board as well as the broader community of Museum members and stakeholders. As a fourth-generation Ukrainian Canadian, and someone who has held a membership to the UMC on-and-off since I moved to Saskatoon in 2008, I feel a profound sense of responsibility to work with this dynamic community to ensure the sustainability and vitality of the Museum for future generations. And with the war in Ukraine still raging on, I remain, every day, humbled by the foresight and determination of the women who founded this institution. Their vision, nearly a century old, has never been more important.

Closing for more than a year, the loss of staff, and some significant financial challenges made a big impact on the organization, but the Board navigated this difficult terrain adeptly. Now, with all-new staff and leadership, the organization is rethinking, reorganizing, and accelerating

efforts to welcome new audiences and build relationships. The efforts of our team to promote new programs and events, modernize our systems and technology, and refresh the building itself have contributed to a strong return of visitors and much positive feedback.

Despite the challenges of the past fiscal year, the Ukrainian Museum of Canada saw some real successes. When a new roof was needed, our community of supporters responded swiftly. Thanks to their support and to funding from Prairies Economic Development Canada, the UMC now has a new roof and has updated several electrical features inside the facility. In 2021-22, upgrades were also made to the Museum's website.

Today, the UMC is turned to the future. Over the year ahead, we will initiate the development of a comprehensive strategic plan. I look forward to conversations and consultations with the Museum's communities and stakeholders as I work with the Board to set and achieve our goals. As the headquarters of a national museum with branches in Toronto, Winnipeg, Edmonton, Calgary, and Vancouver, the UMC must work inventively and collaboratively to strengthen our network and uphold the highest standards of museum management, exhibition-making, and education.

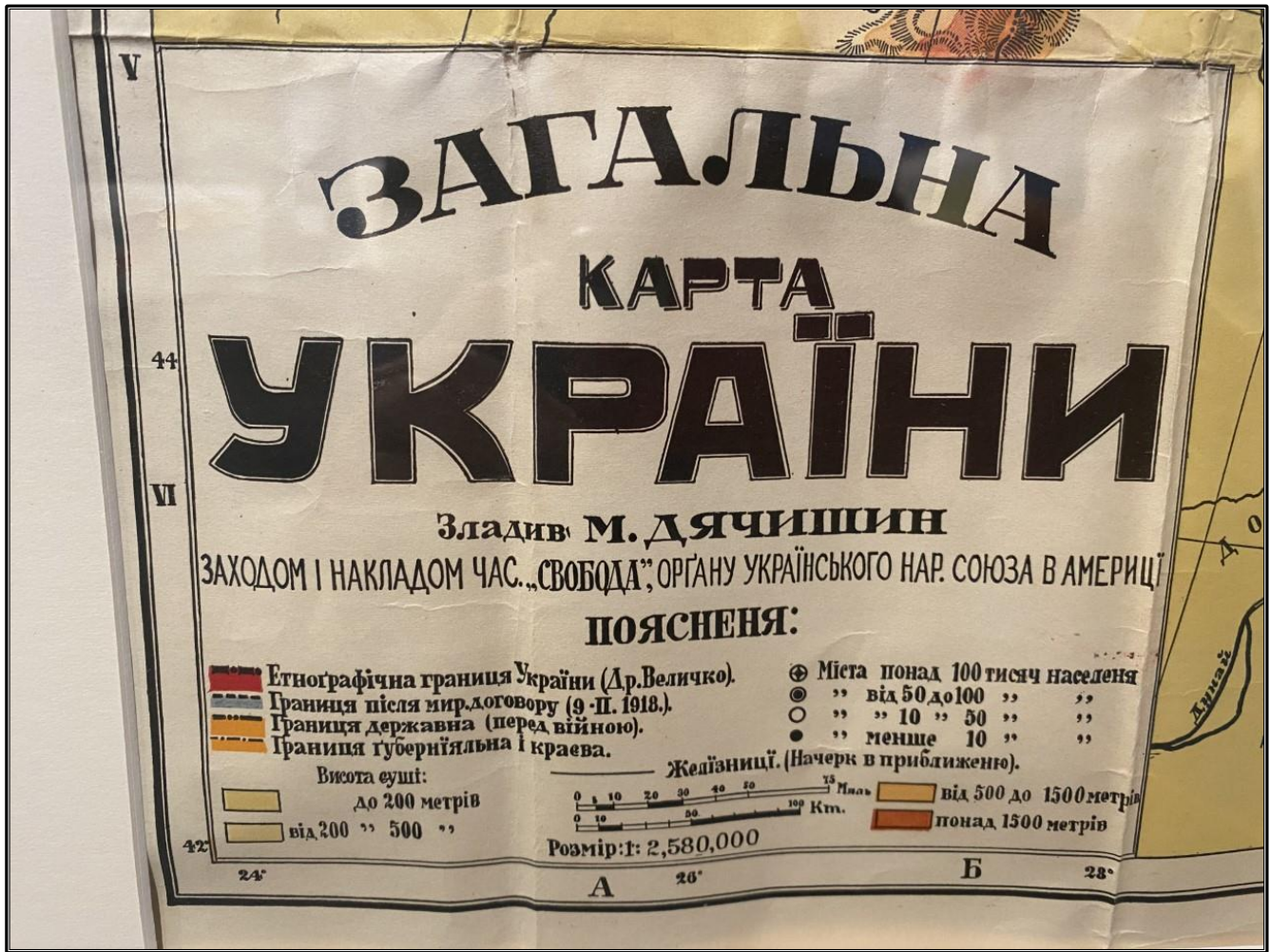

I look forward to working with them – and with you! – in our efforts to heal and grow together through the power of culture and community.

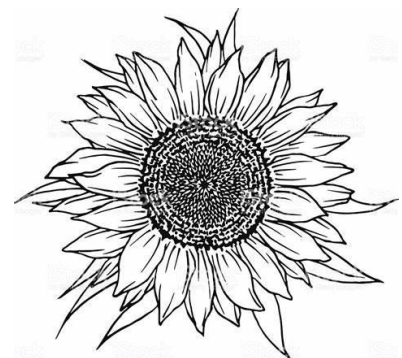
